

Destination Management Committee Meeting under Swadesh Darshan 2.0 Project.

The Swadesh Darshan 2.0 Destination Management Committee, led by Gangtok Collector Tushar Nikhare, recently convened to discuss key initiatives for Gangtok’s tourism development. Sumit Kuliyal (From PDMC, IPE Global Team) outlined SDMS strategic goals, emphasizing job creation, skill development, and private sector investment. Initiatives include Cultural Haat events, MG Alleyways renovation, Heritage Walk proposals, and the “Discover Gangtok” tagline/logo competition.

Gangtok DC chairs Swadesh Darshan 2.0 meeting

GANGTOK, November 23 (IPR): Gangtok collector Tushar Nikhare chaired a meeting with the Destination Management Committee of Swadesh Darshan 2.0 in his office at the district administrative centre, at Sichey today.

The meeting was convened to discuss destination development activities including destination promotion, skill development, IT intervention and others. The primary focus of the meeting was to discuss and strategize the achievements of destination development activity targets set by the Ministry of Tourism for the District Management Committee and Project Development & Management Committee.

During the meeting, progress on the short-listed projects for Gangtok destinations was discussed



mainly Cultural Haat, MG Alley ways upliftment and heritage walk proposals.

A power point presentation was made by Sumit Kuliyal, assistant manager, PDMC, Swadesh Darshan 2.0. He highlighted that the main purpose of the

destination management project is to create a robust framework for the integrated development of tourism destinations in partnership with the States/ UTs and local governments for promoting sustainable and responsible tourism in the country. He

also informed about the strategic objectives of the scheme is to enhance the contribution of tourism to the local economies.

He added that the projects will create jobs including self-employment for local communities, to enhance the

skills of local youth in tourism and hospitality. Further, he said that these projects will increase private sector investment in tourism and hospitality and preserve and enhance local cultural and natural resources.

In the presentation, many awareness activities to spread this concept in the State were discussed.

The tagline and logo competition symbolising the natural beauty of the State on the theme “Discover Gangtok” has been rolled out. Similarly, many plans and exercises will be organised to incorporate this concept in future courses.

SDMs and the representatives from GMC, Tourism & Civil Aviation department, IPR department, Skill Development department and Sikkim Hotel & Restaurant Association were also present at the meeting.

Know Your District**Experience the Tranquility of Lingdum Monastery**


